Please fill in your PHRF rating if you plan on joining in the informal race on 8/14 after the Castine gathering. We expect to race through the Eggemoggin Reach on the way to the next stop: Mackerel Cove. In 2006 and 2008 we had about 8 boats racing, so it should be a lot of fun.

Get the Base PHRF rating from www.phrfne.org. Click on Handicapping, then Base Handicaps. Get handicap adjustments from this same web site by clicking on Handicapping/Handicap Adjustments. If your boat is not listed, use a Base Handicap from another area. Go to www.ussailing.org/phrf/phrfcon.asp to get links. Make sure you select the correct boat. Tartan 37-2 is the 1970s Tartan 37 design, Tartan 37-3 is the Tartan 372, for example.

Typical adjustments will be +12 for no spinnaker (masthead rig), +3 for <135% LP, +6 for solid vs. folding prop, +6 for roller furling (recreational adjustment). Spinnakers are allowed but overlength poles will be penalized per the Handicap Adjustments. Whisker poles are also allowed, but must be attached to the boat, This will be a pursuit race; starting times will be provided the night before. If everyone sails to their rating all will finish at the same time.
