Tartan 34, a highly successful ocean racer, is a keel-centerboarder with skeg-hung rudder, high aspect rig and high ballast to displacement ratio. Standard equipment includes such items as #22 two-speed Barent winches, two #10 Barent halyard winches and stainless steel bow rail. Cockpit is 9'3". Cabin trunk interior is laminated teak; bulkheads are finished in white enamel trimmed with teak. Sole is natural cork with teak hatches. Galley has deck-loading ice box, stainless steel sink, gimbaled stove and generous locker space. Sleeping accommodations are for six with all berths 6'5" or more. Headroom throughout is 6'2". Settee covers midship-positioned Universal (30 hp) Atomic Four.
